The Northwest Power and Conservation Council, through its Columbia River Basin Fish and Wildlife Program, purchased the 35,000-acre Pine Creek ranch in 1999 and 2001 to recover riparian habitat on the ranch as partial mitigation for the impacts of hydropower dams on fish and wildlife in the Columbia Basin. The Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation is restoring the ranch for fish and wildlife habitat.
